Hold Harmless For Use of City Facilities

To the fullest extent permitted by law, renter agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City of Union, its officers, agents, volunteers, and employees from and against all suits, claims, damages, losses, and expenses, including but not limited to attorney's fees, court costs, or alternative dispute resolution costs arising out of, or related to renters use of City's facilities, buildings, equipment or infrastructure under this agreement involving an injury to a person or persons, whether bodily injury or other personal injury (including death), or involving an injury or damage to property (including loss of use or diminution in value), but only to the extent that such suits, claims, damages, losses or expenses are caused by the negligence or other wrongdoing of renter, its officers, agents and volunteers, or anyone directly or indirectly employed or hired by the renter or anyone for whose acts the renter may be liable, regardless of whether caused in part by the negligence or wrongdoing of the City and any of its agents or employees.

WE/ I also agree not to allow entrance to the premises or use of the premises by anyone who has not previously been authorized for entrance for use of the premises or who has not previously agreed to the above Hold Harmless Agreement.

WE/ I also agree to pay for any damages to the premises and/or equipment caused by our use or negligence, excluding normal wear and tear of the premises or equipment.

WE/ I also agree to notify the City of Union or the Union Police Department of any damages or hazardous conditions immediately, and to discontinue use of the premises, until the condition can be corrected.

The renter shall purchase and maintain the following insurance: Commercial General Liability Insurance with a minimum limit of \$1,000,000 each occurrence/\$2,000,000 general aggregate written on an occurrence bases.

All policies of insurance must be on a primary basis, non-contributory with any other insurance and /or self-insurance carried by the City.

Prior to activities commencing the renter shall furnish the City with certificates of insurance evidencing the required coverage, conditions, and limits required by this agreement, have the City named as an additional insured and provide the appropriate additional insured endorsements.

No provision of this agreement shall constitute a waiver of the City's right to assert a defense based on the doctrines of sovereign immunity, official immunity or any other immunity available under law.

Splash Park Rental Policies

Payment Policy

- Fee is \$125 for the pre-established 1.5 hour period.
- A \$25 non-refundable deposit is due seven days from booking and will go towards the total fee.
- Rental fee is due 30 days prior to the rental.
- Renter will be held responsible for all clean up and damage occurring during the scheduled event to the rented area.

Refund Policy

- Rental fee will be refunded, if notice of cancellation is provided in writing to the Parks Director a minimum of 30 days prior to the scheduled rental. A \$10 administrative fee will be charged.
- No refunds will be issued when notice is not given within a minimum of 30 days prior to the scheduled rental.
- No refunds will be issued once rental commences due to inclement weather, etc. If the rental is cancelled due to inclement weather the day of the rental, prior to the start time, the renter can reschedule depending on availability. If no reschedule date is available, a refund will be provided.

Rental Policy

- Rentals are available June 1 – August 31.
- **Renter is not to exceed capacity of facility at any time. Maximum capacity is 65.**
- Rentals must be booked and approved at least two weeks in advance.
- Rentals must take place before or after regular hours of operation and during pre-established times; private parties are not allowed to gather at facility and/or pavilion during normal hours of operation.
- Fee includes Splash Park, use of public restrooms and adjacent pavilion.
 - NO lifeguard or supervisor on duty; use at your own risk.
 - Adjacent playground remains open to the public.
- A ratio of 1 swimming adult to 5 children under the age of 5 must be met at all times. Otherwise, a ratio of 1 swimming adult to 8 children (ages 6+) must be met at all times.
- At no time will furniture or fixtures be moved, removed or rearranged.
- Renter will be responsible for any and all damages to the building and/or contents resulting from usage.
- No person shall mark on or deface the facility.
- No alcohol or tobacco products allowed (e-cigarettes included).
 - Alcohol is not to be served or brought to the facility at any time.
- No glass allowed.
- Renter is allowed to bring outside food and drinks, but must be kept within the pavilion area at all times.
- Renter is responsible for cleaning and placing trash in the proper trash receptacle.
- No staples in tables; use only tape for decorating and remove during clean-up.
- All decorations must be completely removed.
- END TIME of the rental means that the renter has completely vacated the facility, which includes clean up.
- All regular Splash Park Reminders & Rules apply during rentals; see next page and signage on fence.

SPLASH PARK REMINDERS & RULES

1129 Veterans Memorial Drive
Season: May through September
Hours: 10am – 6pm

For the safety of all users, please observe the following:

-  NO LIFEGUARD OR SUPERVISOR ON DUTY; USE AT YOUR OWN RISK
-  NO private parties are to gather at facility during normal hours of operation; rentals are available.
-  Children of all ages must be accompanied AND supervised by an adult at all times
-  Children requiring diapers must wear swim diapers at all times
-  Swim suits or trunks are required for all users at all times
-  Water shoes or sandals are recommended; no street shoes or cleats
-  Drinking the water is prohibited
-  NO bathing; area for recreational purposes only
-  NO tobacco (smoke, chew and/or vapor) products, alcohol and/or drugs
-  NO food or drinks (within the fenced Splash Park area)
-  NO glass containers or breakable objects
-  NO chairs, sports equipment, toys, floats and/or balloons of any kind
-  NO pets or animals of any kind
-  NO climbing, hanging, swinging or pulling on equipment, walls and/or fence
-  NO running; surface can be slippery when wet
-  NO bullying, fighting, roughhousing or foul language
-  NO skateboards, roller blades, skates, bicycles or scooters
-  Not responsible for lost or stolen items
-  Individuals with health conditions, such as diarrhea, nausea, open sores/wounds, infections (skin, eye, ear and/or respiratory) are not permitted (within the fenced Splash Park area)
-  Evacuate area during thunder and/or lightning; play can resume after 30 continuous minutes without thunder and/or lightning
-  Trash, dirt, grass, mulch, etc. will clog the system and cause closures, so keep the area clean
-  Area may be closed at any time due to weather, maintenance or other operational concerns
-  Maximum capacity: 65
